Liberty

Liberty, the county seat for Clay County, has a population of 30,000. It is just a 15-minute drive on I-35 to downtown Kansas City. It has the small-town feel with its historic square that has been recently revitalized, providing many shopping and dining opportunities. The downtown area is surrounded with many well-preserved homes and landmarks. <http://libertymissouri.gov/> It is a growing and vibrant community with a new shopping center, apartment buildings, senior housing and motels all underway.

Major employers:

Liberty Hospital is a major employer in Liberty. It has grown to a 226-bed care center with more than 330 physicians covering all medical specialties and provides a wide range of services. Other major employers include **Hallmark Cards**, **William Jewell College**, **Ford Motor Company**, and **Ferrellgas**.

Liberty Public Schools is the public school district in Liberty, Missouri. Liberty Public Schools encompasses an almost 85 square mile area with more than 11,000 students grades Preschool through 12th in attendance. The district is the fastest growing school district in the state of Missouri, with much of its growth occurring in the last 12 years. The school district currently has 2 high schools (9-12), 1 alternative high school (9-12), 4 middle schools (6-8), 11 elementary schools (K-5), and 1 pre-school.
